DSS 'Helin Award' / High Point Winners

The Helin Tackle Co. Trophy is a memorial award that was originally presented to the Detroit Stereographic Society on its 10th anniversary by Charles Helin, a prominent member of the club. This was a revolving trophy, awarded annually to the member with the highest total point score for the season. After Mr. Helin's death, the Society continued this practice in his honor, until the stereo slide competitions were discontinued in 2013, replaced with digital stereo image competitions.

Until 2010, all competitions involved film-based stereo slides. In that year, we began holding separate competitions for slides and for digital images. Since the 2013-14 season, all competition entries have been digital images.
